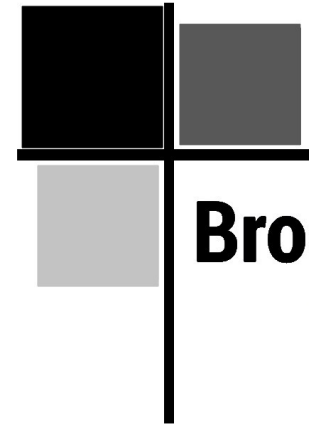

Imagination Station Crafts

We need 3 more helpers to assist the leaders.

Bible Discovery

This is one of the most important stations for VBS. We need 1 more adult leaders and 2 more helpers to lead these sessions. The Bible stories are laid out already. The leaders need to organize how to tell the Bible stories and the helpers will assist.

Survival Leaders

These are the leaders that have the most impact on the children who come for VBS. Each Survival Leader will have a group of kids in whatever grade you sign up for. During VBS, you need to take them to each session.

Wildlife Guides

These are the helpers that assist the Survival Leaders with the group of children from one grade. It is a very fun and rewarding position.

Sound Technician

The sound technician is very important during Sing & Play & Roar. You will need to be able to run the sound board and assist the singers with their cordless mics at the beginning and the end of VBS.

PowerPoint Person

The PowerPoint person needs to be able to run the PowerPoint presentation and various videos during the opening and closing sessions of VBS each day.

Registration

3 more helpers are needed for registration. You will need to check each child in at the beginning of VBS each day. The kids may or may not recite the memory verses that they need to learn to you as well.

These positions all require you to work with children and therefore, you will need a Police Background Check and the Plan to Protect.
