Wedding Vows Are To Be Honored

“Do you take this woman to be your lawfully wedded wife...through sickness and health, until death do you part?” “I do.” “Do you take this man...until death do you part?” “I do.” “Before God and these witnesses, I now pronounce you man and wife.”

Of course, you have heard or spoken similar words at your own or someone's wedding. That moment when someone confirms their vow and intent with “I do” is a little tense. It is a big responsibility to take on. That's the point isn't it? “I do” has to mean something. No one replies “I think so” or “Probably.” Sadly, people treat those words as if they mean nothing.
